

This workbook is designed to provide a brief introduction of our beloved Imam Ali (a), some stories about his childhood and other activities related to his life.




Who is Imam Ali (a)?

Imam Ali (a) is the cousin and son in law of our beloved Prophet Muhammad (s). He is also amongst Ahlul Bayt (a), members of the household of Prophet Muhammad (s), for which Allāh (swt) asked us to respect and love in the Noble Qur'an. Out of the **12 Imams**, Imam Ali (a) is our first Imam.




Imam Ali's (a) father **Abu Talib (a)** was Prophet Muhammad's (s) uncle. Hazrat Abu Talib (a) had trained and instructed Imam Ali (a) from a young age to always support and help our Holy Prophet (s)



The Holy Prophet (s) also had a special love for Imam Ali (a). To help his uncle, he asked Abu Talib (a) to give Imam Ali (a) under his care. Imam Ali (a) was only 6 years old when he came under the care of Prophet Muhammad (s) and his wife Lady Khadija (sa). The Holy Prophet (s) taught many skills to Imam Ali (a) and he became the best in all of them.

Who is Imam Ali (a)?



Miraculous Birth





Fatima binte Asad (sa) was commanded to go inside the Holy Kaaba from that broken wall. Therefore, Imam Ali (a) became the only person to be born inside the Kaaba through the miracle of Allāh.




The Code Words Of Faith




Just as we read The Pledge of Allegiance/ National Anthem in school to commit to our country, when someone decides to accept the religion of Islam they have to read some words to show their belief. These words are called **"Kalimah".**

In the Kalimah we accept the oneness of the **Allāh**, to recognize our Creator. Accept **Prophet Muhammad (s)** as Allāh's Messenger and also declare **Imam Ali (a)** as an appointed guide **(wali)** from Allāh after Prophet Muhammad (s). Once we recite these words we are called **"Muslims"**, meaning those who submit to Allāh and accept Islam as a best religion chosen for us by Allāh.




This means Allāh (swt) gives extra credit for every good deed we perform!






The Defender of Islam

Imam Ali (a) was very fast and intelligent in his fight. The Holy Prophet (s) used to give chances to other fighters to finish the enemies, but they would always remain fearful and hesitant. That's why Prophet Muhammad (s) made Imam Ali (a) the chief to lead the army and Imam Ali (a) would always bring success for Islam.




A Supreme Sword

"There is no sword but Dhul-Fiqar, and there is no hero (man) but Ali (a)."







Battle of Khaybar

The Battle of Khaybar was fought between Muslims and the Jews of Khaybar. The Jews were protecting themselves in one of the big forts.



For many days, the Muslim army was unable to break open the main door and the Jews remain attacking them from the top. On the 40th day the Holy Prophet (s) said: **"Tomorrow I will give the flag to a man who is loved by God and His prophet, and God will give victory to Muslims on his hands, and he never runs away."** Imam Ali (a) was sick at that time and was in Medina.



The next morning Prophet Muhammad (s) with the command of Allāh called out Imam Ali (a) by reciting **"Nade Ali" (especial words to call Imam Ali for help).** The Prophet's voice reached Imam Ali (a)'s ears and he immediately grabbed his horse and within minutes reached in front of the Holy Prophet (s).

The Muslim Army was surprised to see Imam Ali (a). But the Prophet (s) knew Ali (a) would be the only one who could win this battle.

Battle of Khaybar



The Prophet (a) gave Imam Ali (a) the flag and informed him about the fort. The horns were blown and the Jewish army sent their bravest soldier **Marhab**.

When Marhab came out he yelled, " I'm Marhab, who dare to fight with the best warrior?" There was silence for few moments then everyone heard Imam Ali's (a) voice:

'MY MOTHER NAMED ME HAYDER. I WILL FIGHT YOU."

Imam Ali (a) moved his sword quickly and cut Marhab into two pieces. Then he moved closer to the fort, grabbed it's door and took it out of the wall. The Jews became astonished and ran away from his site. Imam Ali (a) then used that door as shield and killed the Jewish soldiers.
